Department of Road Transport & Highways, on behalf of President of India, invites separate applications for pre-qualification from the interested applicants for the following projects on Design, Part Finance, Build, Maintain and Transfer basis:-

1	Widening of existing 2-lane NH 37 & 37A from Nagaon to Tezpur, via Silghat to 4-lane divided highway, including construction of an additional 3-lane major bridge & rehabilitation of the existing bridge over river Brahmaputra and construction of new 4-lane highway from Tezpur to Jamgudi along with a major bridge over Jia Bharali river at Chowkhighat in Assam	80	1600	36
2	Construction of 12m wide permanent bridge connecting Dhola and Sadia ghats on NH 37 and connecting approaches	28	700	36
3.	Widening of existing road to 2-lane NH standards along with improvement and re-alignment from Nechipu to Hoj, via Seppa, Saggali. (part of Trans Arunachal Highway)	311	1200	36
4.	Widening of existing road to 2-lane NH standards along with improvement and re-alignment from Potin to Pangin, via Yachuli, Ziro, Daporizo, Aalong (part of Trans Arunachal Highway)	412	1600	36
5	Construction of 12m wide permanent bridges: (i) Debang valley along with approaches connecting Bojanir and Meka; (ii) over Lohit river connecting Digaru and Chowkham, NH 52 (part of Trans Arunachal Highway)	30	900	36
