## Subject: Release of funds to various States/UTs out of Central Road Fund during the year 2007-08 (Arunachal Pradesh).

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the release of funds to the tune of Rs. 16.74 Crore (Rupees Sixteen Crore Seventy Four Lakh Only) to the State of Arunachal Pradesh out of Central Road Fund for the financial year 2007-08. This is the first installment of release to the State of Arunachal Pradesh during the year 2007-08.

2. These funds should be used for the projects approved as per Central Road Fund (State Roads) Rule, 2007 circulated to various State Governments/UTs as per this Ministry's letter No. NH-11011/2/2000-P&M dated 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2007.

3. For the funds to be utilized under the on-going old CRF Schemes, the State Governments are requested to ensure the funding pattern laid down in the sanction letters of the Ministry.

4. Utilisation Certificate for the funds previously released to State has been received.

5. The State Govt. has submitted the Completion Certificate of the works which have been completed by them.

6. The State Govt. has submitted a certificate that Display Boards on all the sanctioned jobs under CRF have been installed.

7. As required under the New CRF Rules, referred to above, the State Government will be required to furnish the quarterly progress report as per Form-II of the letter *ibid*.

8. The P.A.O. (NH) is authorized to issue necessary credit advice for this payment.

9. The State Government will be required to furnish the Utilization Certificate duly verified by the Regional Officer in accordance with new Rules referred to above, as per Form-I along with the quarterly progress report.

10. The State Government is also required to furnish the completion report/certificate duly certified by the Audit as and when the works are completed.

11. The expenditure is debitable under he major Head "3601" Grants in Aid to State Govts. 02-01.00.31-Grants-in-Aid corresponding to Demand No. 85 – Ministry of Shipping, Road Transport & Highways, Department of Road Transport & Highways, for the year 2007-2008.

12. This sanction issues with the concurrence of Finance Wing vide their U.O. No. 2694/TP.II/2007 dated 7.3.2008.
